AUIDS 101 (Fall 3-week) The First-Year Seminar prepares students for university by teaching critical analysis, improving academic writing, fostering community involvement and introducing career skills.	Collaborative Seminar (Fall 11-week) Option: AUIDS 301 (Winter 3 & 11) Develops teamwork skills through multidisciplinary projects, enhancing career readiness in project management, communication and teamwork.
