




Video Projector Reference Guide



- **DISPLAY ON / OFF.** This will lower the projector screen and turn on the projector. Display OFF will turn off projector and retract the screen.
- Turn **VOLUME** dial to increase or decrease audio level.
- Select **SOURCE** button on the control panel to switch inputs.
 - PC** – Switches to the classroom desktop computer.
 - LAPTOP HDMI** – Switches to the HDMI cable input for connection to Laptop
- **SCREEN UP/DN** – Raises or lowers the projection screen.
Wait for screen to fully retract before toggling off the switch to lower it.
- **Camera Pre-sets** – 3 pre-programmed whiteboard positions.
Desktop Lecture Capture AV Settings: Video = **AV.ioHD** , Speakers = **ExtronScalerD**, Microphone = **Jack Mic**
- **ALL Mute** – Projector's image and source audio is muted. Press again to unmute.



NO PICTURE?

- ✓ **Press Display ON** (wait 8 seconds)
- ✓ **Press the desired Source button on the control panel.**
- ✓ **If no image shows on your input, select another source, wait three seconds, and then switch back to the desired Source again.**

PC – for desktop PC display.

LAPTOP HDMI – for HDMI cable input.

- ✓ **To display a mirror image onto the projector screen, the Duplicate project mode needs to be active. Press these 2 keys together (“win”+“P”) on your device’s keyboard and select Duplicate from the project menu on the right side of the screen.**



- ✓ **If you still do not get picture then turn display OFF, wait for flashing to stop and turn display ON again.**
- ✓ **Wait at least 8 seconds for red flashing light to stop before selecting source button**

NO SOUND?

- ✓ **Turn VOLUME dial clockwise to increase audio level. A few turns past the red LED indicator will reach max volume.**
- ✓ **Set your device & in-app volume level slider to 100%**
