



WKEXP 902 WORK TERM ASSIGNMENT

Principles of Safety and Risk Management

PURPOSE

This assignment offers students practical exposure to safety and risk management in real-world work settings. Through video modules, quizzes, and a safety perception survey, students will develop the skills to identify hazards, manage risk, and engage in workplace safety culture. The assignment bridges learning with professional responsibility, helping students become safety-conscious engineers who contribute to the well-being of their organizations and communities.

FORMAT

The structured, modular WKEXP 902 assignment consists of the following components, delivered through the our learning management system (Canvas):

- Three video modules with accompanying supplementary material
- Three online quizzes (multiple attempts allowed, 100% required to pass)
- One [Safety Perception Survey](#) completed via GoogleForm

The entire assignment takes approximately four hours to complete and must be done during your WKEXP 902 placement.

ASSIGNMENT

To successfully complete the WKEXP 902 work term assignment, all students must:

- Watch each video module and review any additional materials
- Complete the corresponding quiz by the specified due date. Quizzes are not timed and may be attempted multiple times. A final score of 100% is required for each quiz.
- Complete the Safety Perception Survey onsite via GoogleForm and complete the Safety Perception Survey Confirmation of Completion in Canvas. This survey is a valuable learning tool that explores your views on safety culture, practices, and communication within your work environment. It plays a vital role in:
 - Identifying improvement areas in workplace safety
 - Assessing organizational safety culture
 - Understanding employee well-being and safety engagement
 - Supporting compliance and risk management efforts
 - Measuring the impact of safety initiatives

Your thoughtful participation contributes to your learning and supports broader safety education efforts across the Faculty of Engineering. As safety is a vital aspect of any worksite, we encourage students to work collaboratively with their supervisor or colleagues to complete this survey.

Ultimately, safety mindsets stress safety and risk management as verbs not nouns; they are responsive, dynamic, and designed to keep people, equipment, and product safe and mitigate harm. The results of your Safety Perception Survey will not be shared with your employer without your consent and will be kept confidential to co-op office staff. As your safety and
