

UPLOAD AND WIN CONTEST

CONTEST RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

- 1. CONTEST: Upload and Win** (the "**Contest**") is conducted by The Governors of the University of Alberta (the "**University**") and administered on behalf of the University by the University's ONEcard office.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible for the Contest (an "**Eligible Entrant**"):
 - (a) you must be sixteen (16) years of age or older; and
 - (b) you must be a new student to the University of Alberta; and
 - (c) you must be eligible for a University's Student ONEcard for the Fall 2025 term.

You are not eligible for the Contest if you are a resident of Quebec. You are not eligible for the Contest if, during the Entry Period (defined below), you are a staff member, academic visitor, or contractor of the University of Alberta, or an employee of the University's ONEcard office, including a member of the immediate family (defined as mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, husband or wife, regardless of where they reside). All decisions regarding eligibility to enter the Contest will be determined by the University in its sole discretion. The Contest is void where prohibited by law.

- 3. NUMBER, APPROXIMATE VALUE OF PRIZE AND CHANCES OF WINNING:** There are five (5) prizes available to be won for the Entry Period. The Prizes are described in further detail in paragraph 9 below. The chances of winning a Prize will depend on the number of Eligible Entrants received in accordance with these Contest Rules during the Entry Period as defined herein.

- 4. CONTEST SCHEDULE:** This Contest commences at 12:00 a.m. (Edmonton time) on Monday, June 23, 2025 and closes at 11:59 p.m. (Edmonton time) on Wednesday, August 13, 2025 (the "**Entry Period**"). An Entry Submission (defined below) must be received during the Entry Period to be eligible to win a Prize.

- 5. HOW TO ENTER:** No purchase is necessary to enter the Contest. To enter, an Eligible Entrant must upload their ONEcard photo through the University's authenticated upload site using the Single Sign-On (SSO) system on the ONEcard website (the "**Entry Submission**") during the Entry Period. Each approved photo submission made by an Eligible Entrant during the Entry Period, and in accordance with these Contest Rules, shall constitute an Entry Submission.

Once submitted, all Entry Submissions become the property of the University and will not be returned. All Entry Submissions will be reviewed, and any Entry Submissions that are deemed to be late, illegible, incomplete, inaccurate, inappropriate, offensive, plagiarized, subject to copyright or other intellectual property considerations, do not meet

the *Alberta Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* ("FOI/PPA") or privacy considerations, as set out in paragraph 19 herein, and otherwise, or which are deemed to not enhance the reputation of the University, will be disqualified. The determination of whether an Entry Submission is illegible, incomplete, offensive, late, or deemed to not enhance the reputation of the University will be at the sole discretion of the University.

6. PRIZE DRAW DETAILS: There will be a total of five (5) computer-aided random draws (the "**Draws**" or each, a "**Draw**") conducted in this Contest. The Contest draws will take place at approximately 12:00 p.m. (Edmonton Time) on Thursday, August 14, 2025. The Eligible Entrants who have complied with these Contest Rules and whose Entry Submissions are drawn, including without limitation the provisions of paragraph 8, will be declared the winners of a Prize (the "**Winner**"; collectively "the Winners"). If necessary, should any Prize be unclaimed, or should a Winner be unwilling, unable or ineligible to win a Prize as set out in these Contest Rules, the Prize will be forfeited and the University shall have the right, but not the obligation, to draw, as replacements only, additional Entry Submissions. All participants (including without limitation Eligible Entrants and the Winners) must comply with these Contest Rules. All matters relating to the Draws and the verification of the eligibility of Eligible Entrants to be declared as Winners will be conducted by the University's ONEcard office, or by persons designated by the University's ONEcard office in its sole and absolute discretion. All decisions made by the University's ONEcard office in this regard are final and binding and cannot be challenged. No communication with Eligible Entrants will be entered into except with the Winners, which will be selected in accordance with these Contest Rules.

7. NOTIFICATION: The University will notify the Winners immediately following the draws on Thursday, August 14, 2025. The University's ONEcard Office will contact the Winners using the information provided by the Eligible Entrants when the Entry Submission has been submitted via the University's Single Sign-On (SSO) system. If the Winners do not respond to the email by Friday, August 29, 2025 at 12:00 p.m. (Edmonton Time), the ONEcard Office shall have the right, but not the obligation, to select an alternative Winner.

8. DECLARATION OF WINNERS: An Eligible Entrant will not be declared a Winner in accordance with these Contest Rules unless and until:

- (a) The University has verified that the Winners are Eligible Entrants pursuant to these Contest Rules; and
- (b) The Eligible Entrants correctly answer a skill-testing question as set out in these Contest Rules.

9. PRIZES: There will be five (5) Prizes, each consisting of \$100.00 (CDN) being awarded directly to the Winner's ONEcard account on or before Friday, September 5, 2025. Prizes are not redeemable for cash and are non-refundable, but can be spent at any participating location on the University campus. The original deposit made to a Winner, however, is eligible for a refund as set out in the ONEcard cardholder agreement. All Prizes are non-transferable and must be accepted as awarded with no substitutions, except at the University's sole discretion. The University reserves the right to substitute a Prize of equivalent monetary value if the University is unable to award the Prize as described. The University will not be responsible, however, if factors beyond the University's reasonable control prevents the Prizes from being fulfilled. In any such event, a Winner will not be provided with a substitute prize or cash equivalent. The Prizes will only be granted to the verified Winners. The Winners of the Prizes must contact the ONEcard office for the deposit to be made directly to their ONEcard account.

10. SKILL TESTING QUESTION: To win a Prize, the Eligible Entrants must correctly answer, unaided, the mathematical, time-limited, skill-testing question as follows: $60 \text{ multiplied by } 4 \text{ divided by } 2 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$ prior to being declared a Winner.

11. CONTEST MODIFICATION OR CANCELLATION: The University reserves the right, without prior notice and at any time, to delay or terminate the Contest, in whole or in part, or modify, suspend, amend or extend the Contest in any way, in its sole discretion including, without limitation, if the University determines that the Contest is not practicable or is impaired or corrupted or that fraud or technical problems, failures or malfunctions (including without limitation, computer viruses, glitches or printing or production errors) have destroyed or severely undermined the proper conduct, integrity, and/or feasibility of the Contest. In the event the University is prevented from continuing with the Contest as contemplated herein by any event beyond its control, including but not limited to fire, flood, natural or man made epidemic or health or other means, earthquake, explosion, labour dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, riot or civil disturbance, terrorist threat or activity, war or any federal, provincial or local government law, order, or regulation, public health crisis, the order of any court or jurisdiction, or by any other cause not reasonably within the University's control (each a "Force Majeure" event), then subject to any governmental approval which may be required, the University shall have the right to modify, suspend, extend or terminate the Contest.

12. PARTICIPATION: Participation in this Contest constitutes an agreement by each participant to comply with these Contest Rules.

13. DISQUALIFICATION: It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that he/she has complied in full with all of the conditions and requirements contained in these Contest Rules. If any Eligible Entrant or Entry Submission is found to be ineligible, or if an Eligible Entrant has not complied with these Contest Rules or declines the Prize for any reason prior to award, such Eligible Entrant or Entry Submission will be disqualified and, in the University's sole discretion, an alternate Winner may be selected. No mechanically reproduced, illegible, incomplete, forged, software generated or other automated multiple entries will be accepted. The University reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual (including an Eligible Entrant) who is found to be tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Contest; to be acting in violation of these Contest Rules; or to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with the intent to disrupt or undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest, or to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person.

14. RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION: By entering the Contest, each participant: (a) releases and agrees to hold the University and its respective directors, officers, employees, and agents, harmless from and against any and all costs, injuries, losses or damages of any kind, including, without limitation, bodily injury and property damage, or any other damage or loss, due in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, to participation in this Contest, any Contest related activity, or from acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any Prize, or participation in any Prize related activity; and (b) agrees to fully indemnify the University and its directors, officers, employees, and agents, from any and all claims on the part of any third party or parties related in any way and for any reason to the Contest or to any of the Prizes including, without limitation, death, and personal or property damage or injury.

15. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: The University assumes no responsibility or liability for incorrect, damaged, illegible, incomplete, mutilated, spoiled, destroyed, stolen, misplaced, lost, late, misdirected or incomplete Entry

Submissions, which may be judged void, any notifications, responses, replies, or for any computer, telephone, hardware, software or technical malfunctions that may occur. The University assumes no responsibility for any theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, Entry Submissions. The University is not responsible for any injury or damage to participants in this Contest.

16. PUBLICITY RELEASE: By entering this Contest, each participant who submits an Entry Submission agrees and grants to the University, without further compensation, the unrestricted rights, but not the obligation, to the use the entirety of the Entry Submission, and to use his/her name, picture, portrait, likeness, voice, along with his/her address (City and Province) and any statements made by or attributed to such Eligible Entrant, or other individuals associated with an Entry Submission, in any and all media, now known or hereafter devised, without notice, review or approval, in perpetuity and throughout the universe, for educational, advertising and promotional purposes in connection with the Contest and any other promotions and programs, whatsoever, without further notice or compensation and hereby releases the University from any liability with respect thereto.

17. OFFICIAL RULES AND LAWS: These are the official Contest rules (the "**Contest Rules**"). This Contest is governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Province of Alberta and federal laws of Canada applicable therein and the parties hereby attorn to the jurisdiction of the courts of the Province of Alberta. In the event a court determines that this Choice of Law clause is invalid or unenforceable as against an Entry Submission, such Entry Submission will be void. These Contest Rules are subject to change without notice in order to comply with any applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws or the policy of any other entity having jurisdiction over the University. These Contest Rules, as amended from time to time, will be posted at the University's ONEcard office at 9104 HUB Mall, Edmonton, Alberta, and online at www.onecard.ualberta.ca/ContestRules.

18. CONSTRUCTION: Words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Contest Rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these Contest Rules shall otherwise remain in effect and be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained in these Contest Rules. Headings and captions are used in these Contest Rules solely for ease of reference, and shall not be deemed to affect in any manner the meaning or intent of these Contest Rules or any provision hereof. These Contest Rules cannot be modified or amended in any way except in writing by a duly authorized representative of the University. Employees of the University are not authorized to modify, amend or waive these Contest Rules.

19. PRIVACY: The personal information requested pursuant to these Contest Rules is collected, used and disclosed under the authority of the *Alberta Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* ("FOIPP") and will be protected in accordance with Part 2 of that Act. It will be collected, used and disclosed for the purpose of administration of the Contest. All personal information collected for the purposes of administration of the Contest will be retained for two (2) years from the closing of the Contest.
